

USE OF COOKIES

If you browse our website, you will be accepting the use of cookies under the conditions established in this Cookies Policy. This policy can be updated, so we invite you to review it regularly.

WHAT ARE COOKIES?

They are small data files that the Internet server sends to the device with which you connect to our websites and which it stores. They are only associated with your browser and do not themselves provide personal data. Cookies cannot harm your device and are also very useful, since they help us identify and resolve errors. SOCIAL NETWORK COOKIES

- Google Chrome 10 and higher - Incognito
- Safari 2 and higher - Private Browsing
- Firefox 3.5 and higher - Private Browsing
